## Title Child Hanging Upside Down From Trapeze Bar

Description View of a child, probably a boy, hanging upside down from a trapeze bar. The bar is suspended by rope. The boy is holding the bar with both hands and has his feet hooked around the ropes on each end. There is a pile of lumber on the ground just behind him, in front of a tree. There is a one-story building to the left and another small building in the background.
