Description Drawing of the former Third Judicial District Courthouse (also called the Jefferson Market Courthouse), subsequently the Jefferson Market Library, in Manhattan. The High Victorian building is depicted at the corner of Sixth Avenue and Tenth Street, with its tower emphasized through the inclusion of more detail than the rest of the building. Other buildings and pedestrian and automobile traffic are also shown.
