Description Large stone and brick industrial buildings seen across mill pond on the Farmington River. The dam is at the left. One of the buildings has a smokestack, dormers and a square tower. The right building has a mansard roof.

An iron exterior staircase runs down the side of the left building. Inscribed on back: "Dunham Mills / First Worsted Mill / in U.S. / Poquonock, Conn., town of Windsor." "Alfred Dieu came from France. All French Machinery."
