Description Shop window displaying multiple copies of *The Lure of Gold* by William B. Goodwin. The display also features armor, weapons, possibly a pike and a halberd, and other artifacts labeled as follows: "Georgia Deeds / with great seal / of George III" "Spanish Buff Coat / Steel Breastplate / during time of Columbus" "Spanish / Jewel Chest / used in late 1500" "The Story of the New World / Printed in 1593" "Spanish Coins, Austrian Gun / Pieces of Eight" "Model / Columbus flagship / Santa M[aria]." A poster advertises "Gardens / Open to the Public / Tues May 14th Wed 15th / In case of rain gardens will be open the next day / Houses and gardens in Hartford / West Hartford and Farmington. / Tickets \$1.50 before May 9.
