Description Canoes are drawn up on the bank of the Connecticut River in the foreground. They are painted with designs that are meant to be Native American. Two barges are on the river at the right. A group of men and women in seventeenth-century costume stand on the shore with a yoke of oxen and a horse. Additional costumed re-enactors are near teepees. Crowds of spectators are in the left and right background. The Bulkeley Bridge is in the distance.
