Medium silk; embroidery thread

Description Woman's apron made of silk and embroidered with a leaf and flower pattern of various colors. The apron was designed by Mrs. Abigail P. Annable and worked on by Elizabeth C. Annable (Mrs. Joseph Kellogg). The apron is made of a tan silk with a linen, loose-weave backing. There is a multi-colored embroidered line along the edges. (a) apron (b) note

Dimensions Skirt (apron length x width of hem): $29 \frac{1}{2} \times 29$ in. (74.9×73.7 cm)

Other (height x width of note): $4 \frac{1}{8} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (10.5×14 cm)
