Description Black and white photograph by Thomas F. Oakes of Wilhelmstrasse, a major thoroughfare in Berlin, Germany; until 1945, it was recognized as the center of the Nazi government. There is rubble in the left-hand foreground and buildings that line the boulevard have been damaged by the bombing of Berlin, 1944-1945.
