To conquer foes and cheer His friends.

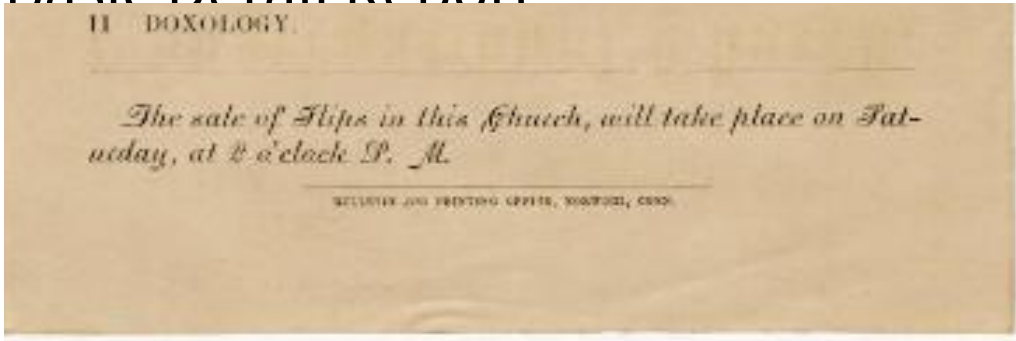
