Description Photographs of dolls made by Ivelisse Pabón de Landrón. The photographs were submitted with her application to Year 15 of the Southern New England Apprenticeship Program. In Year 15 she was the teaching artist in Puerto Rican doll making to apprentice Amanda Mercado.
