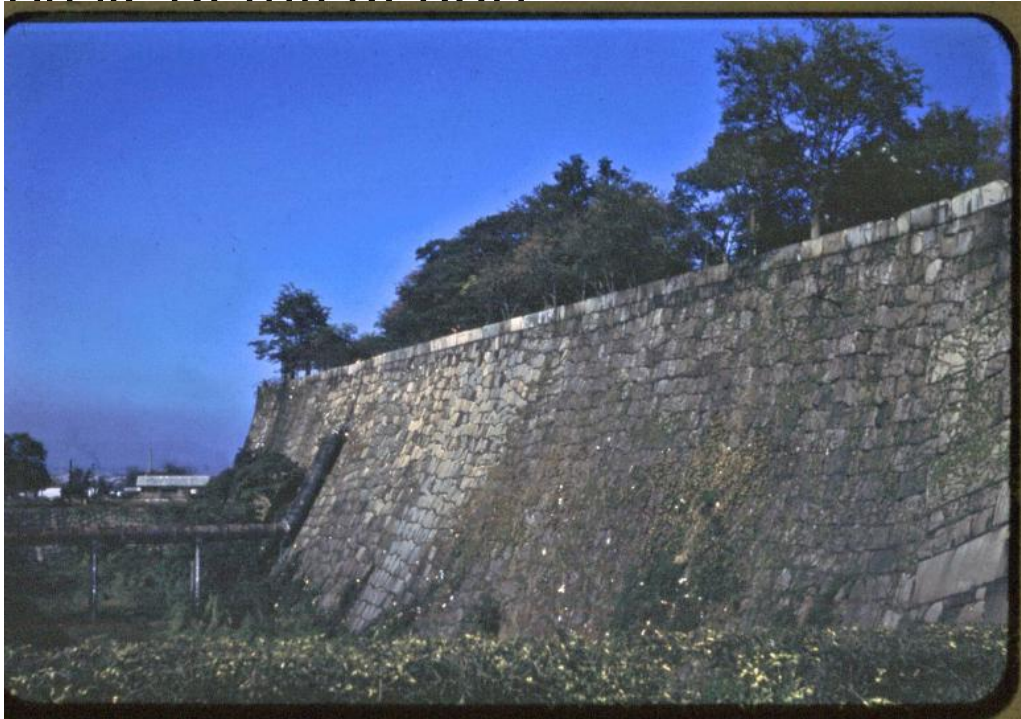

Title Views of Osaka, Japan, 1952

Description Color mounted slides of views in Osaka, Japan in 1952 during the Korean War. (.87) A landscape view of a tall stone wall structure with trees sitting at the top of it. Flowers and plants are seen on the ground at the bottom of the structure. (.88) Four children's strollers sitting at the bottom of the steps in front of a short stone wall. Japanese writing is seen on the poles to the left of the carriages. (.89-.90) A close-up view of men, women, and children in front of the stone wall entrance of Osaka Castle. (.91) A close-up view of people walking around the entrance and/or exit of a building. A car is seen parked on the right side of the image. (.92-.93) Landscape view of a city in Japan taken from behind a wired fence. Mountains are seen in the background. (.94) A high-rise stone wall

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structure with a white building sitting at the top of it. The building is two stories

high with a black roof. (.95) A high-rise river stone wall with a white building

sitting at the top right of it. Trees are next to the building. (.96) Up close view of

men and women walking down the steps of the stone wall entrance of Osaka

Castle. (.97) Close-up view of the entrance of a railroad station. Above the arc of

the entrance sits a large Buddha statue from the chest up. The Buddha holds out

its hands with numerous smaller dancing characters on them. (.98) A street view

of an intersection at Osaka. Transportation vehicles are on the road to the right

of the image. Pedestrians are walking on the sidewalk. Overhead power lines are

in the background. (.99) A view of pedestrians walking on a rubble path that is

on the side of a building. Trees are in the background.
