and Muslim faiths, stood on the steps of Hartford's City Hall to denounce racism

and to demand from Mayor Luke Bronin and representatives of the Hartford

Police Department and the Hartford Police Union for the reinstatement of the

citizen review board and other matters concerning police accountability. Rev.
