Title Pair of Ensign Shoulder Boards

Description A pair of Ensign shoulder boards owned by George Wells Cheney, Jr. during World War II. Black shoulder board with one gold stripe and gold star. Small brass button with an American eagle covers the snap at one end. Leather strap to hold the board onto the uniform.
