Medium Ambrotype; collodion on glass with dark backing in brass mat package in wooden case covered with tooled leather; red velvet pad in left side of open case

Description Ninth plate ambrotype of Edith Maria Bromley as a little girl of perhaps three to five years of age. She is sitting in a chair with turned elements visible behind her on the left. Edith is wearing a dress with a wide neckline, a pleated bodice, and puffed sleeves. Her hands are folded in her lap. Her shoulder-length hair is worn in ringlets.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. (6.4 × 5.1cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ in. (7.3 × 6.4 × 1.3cm)
