Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype by Edward White (NY) of Samuel Terry, Eli Terry's brother and a clockmaker in his own right. Terry is shown in old age, and is wearing a suit, a white shirt with an upturned collar, and a dark-colored necktie.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3 × 7cm) Other (case height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (9.5 × 8.3 × 1.3cm)
