Medium Tintype; collodion on lacquered iron in brass window mat package in thermoplastic case. Embossed purple velvet pad in left side of open case.

Description Sixteenth-plate tintype portrait of a girl named Mary Callender or Callendens. The bust-length portrait shows her wearing a plaid dress with a white collar fastened with a brooch. Her hair appears to be gathered in the back in a fringed headpiece.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $1\frac{5}{8} \times 1\frac{3}{8}$ in. (4.1 × 3.5cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $2\frac{1}{8} \times 1\frac{7}{8} \times \frac{3}{4}$ in. (5.4 × 4.8 × 1.9cm)
