**Title** John Churchill

**Date** 1851

**Primary Maker** John Churchill

**Medium** Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate in brass window mat package, originally housed in a wooden frame (now in pieces)

**Description** Sixth-plate daguerreotype of a painting of John Churchill attributed to Dr. Samuel Broadbent (1945.1.20). The daguerreotype is laterally reversed

(due to the nature of the daguerreotype process). Churchill is a young man

wearing a dark coat and a shirt with a high, white ruffled stock. He is holding a

quill pen in his left hand.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3 × 7cm) Frame (frame

height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{3}{8} \times \frac{3}{8}$ in. (9.5 × 8.6 × 1cm)
