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Description Ninth-plate ambrotype of Mary Francis Bull Clark by an unknown

photographer. Clark is posed in front of a painted backdrop. She is wearing a

dark dress with a large brooch at the throat. Her hair is parted in the middle and

pulled back into what seems to be a low bun or plaited bun.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. (6.4×5.1 cm) Other (case height

x width x depth): $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{3}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ($7.3 \times 6 \times 1.3$ cm)
