Basic Detail Report

Description Ninth-plate ambrotype of a young man in the Case family. He is wearing a jacket, a garment that might be a vest, and a dotted white shirt. This ensemble is finished with a bowtie and a double button closure. His hair is fashioned into a small puff above his forehead.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width): $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. (6.4×5.1 cm)

Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{4}$ in. ($7.6 \times 6.4 \times 0.6$ cm)
