Description Images of and relating to the Willard Family, including: two images of large groups of men, women and some children, most wearing hats, possibly at family reunions, one group stands in front of the Bunker Hill Monument and Col. Prescott statue in Boston, in the other image the group is standing in front of an ivy covered brick building; two images of different granite boulders, both with dedications to Simon Willard; one group picture of a group of men, Hartford's Young Man's C. A. Glee Club in 1930 at a concert in Jewell Hall.
