Description Postcard views of various Connecticut locations include, in Hartford: the Old State House; 'New' City Hall; and various images of the Flood of 1936, including Bushnell Park, the Capitol grounds, Corning Fountain, the Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Arch, the Bond Hotel on Asylum Street, freight yards at Morgan Street, the telephone building on Trumbull Street, and a used car lot on Connecticut Boulevard. In a packet from the 75th anniversary celebration of the University of Connecticut: the Brundage Memorial pool; the campus in winter and spring; the auditorium; the lower lounge of the auditorium, and an interior view; the Wilbur Cross library; the student union building, including interior views of the browsing room and the United Nations room; the College of Agriculture; Storrs Hall, and the School of Business Administration.
