Included are a view of Stony Creek in Branford; the P.T. Monument and Museum in Bridgeport; the American Clock and Watch Museum in Bristol; Chamard Vineyard in Clinton; the Glastonbury-Rocky Hill ferry; Goodspeed Opera House in East Haddam; the Coast Guard barque Eagle in Groton; Faulkner's Island Lighthouse off Guilford; Constitution Plaza, the skyline from Bushnell Park, and the Lady Fenwick on the Connecticut River at Hartford; the White Memorial Conservation Center in Litchfield; the Green, the First Congregational Church, the Memorial Tower, and Charles Island in Milford; the Slater Memorial Museum in Norwich; Dinosaur State Park in Rocky Hill; Heublein Tower in Simsbury; the Millstone Nuclear Power Plant in Waterford; the Frog Bridge sculpture by Leo Jensen in Willimantic; the John Mason statue, the Lieutenant Walter Fyler House, the Windsor Public Library, and the Elm Grove Mortuary Chapel in Windsor; and airplanes at the New England Air Museum in Windsor Locks.
