## **Title Infant's Bib**

Date about 1850-1875

Primary Maker Martha L. Woodworth

Medium Hand-stitched linen

Description Infant's bib of white linen woven in a bird's-eye twill. The bib has armholes and opens at center back. The bib is shaped with rounded corners.

There is a point at the center front neckline. All edges are scalloped and finished with buttonhole stitches worked in red thread.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width): 9 x 15 1/4in. (22.9 x 38.7cm)
