

# Basic Detail Report

## **Title Central Portion of the Slab, with Foot Prints and Scroll.**

Date July 1842

Primary Maker E.B. & E.C. Kellogg

Medium Lithography; printer's ink on wove paper

Description A rectangular slab, apparently of stone, has two human footprints and a scroll-like outline superimposed on other random imprints, possibly from leaves or the action of water. A crack extends from the top to the bottom of the piece of stone.
