

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Plate

Date about 1950

Primary Maker The Hartford Fire Insurance Company

Medium Mechanically-molded porcelain with green decoration

Description Round, ivory, porcelain plate with green printed decoration at the rim. A band of green has been applied around the rim, which is interrupted to one side by two circular emblems bearing the name of the Hartford Fire Insurance Company. The first emblem has an elk inside a double circle, with, "THE HARTFORD FIRE INSURANCE CO/ HARTFORD CONN" printed in the band between the two circles. The second emblem consists of a deer or elk with antlers in front of a castle, inside a double circle. "HARTFORD ACCIDENT AND INDEMNITY COMPANY/ HARTFORD CONN" is printed between the two circles. There is an undulating line printed outside the double circles of the second emblem. There are several light scratches on the surface of the plate.
