

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Teacup and Saucer

Date late 19th-early 20th century

Primary Maker Richard Briggs Co.

Medium Mold-formed porcelain with gilding and overglaze enamels in black and orange

Description Round, porcelain teacup (.a) and saucer (.b) with gilding and enameling in orange and black. Both the teacup and saucer have a gilded rim with a band of orange just below which has a gilded scalloped line on either side. The band of orange is interrupted three times by a symmetrical cluster of scrolls in black and gilt. The gilded initials "C.L.K." are found opposite the handle of the teacup. The gilding has worn off portions of the handle of the teacup and the rims of the teacup and saucer. There is a hairline crack running through the center of the saucer.

Dimensions Component (height x width including handle x depth of teacup): 2 x 4 1/4 x 3 1/2in. (5.1 x 10.8 x 8.9cm) Component (diameter of saucer): 5 3/8in. (13.7 cm)
