## Title Plate

Date mid 20th century

Primary Maker Ruth Trappan

Medium Mechanically-molded porcelain with overglaze enamels

Description Small, round, porcelain plate with a printed pattern in green, peach, grey, brown, blue, and black enamels. The pattern shows a mill wheel in water to the left, connected to a wooden mill building with a Dutch roof to the right. A stone wall and wooden fence separate the open area in front of the mill from the water to the left.
