## Title Vials

Date 1820-1860

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Blown aquamarine glass

Description Blown aquamarine glass vial with a flared rim, a short cylindrical neck, rounded shoulders, a cylindrical body, and a pontil mark and a medium kick on the bottom. Kick: An indentation in the bottom of a drinking glass, bottle, or other glass object. Pontil mark: A rough place on a blown glass object where the solid metal rod, or pontil, is cracked off the object after final shaping and decoration. Pontil marks can be polished to achieve a smooth surface. This vial is supposed to be one of a group of four. Vials .2-.4 were unlocated at the time of data entry.
