Title Cordial Glass

Medium Blown colorless glass, green paint, and gilding

Description Cordial glass made of blown colorless glass. The cordial glass has an inverted bell-shaped bowl, a slender, tapered stem with a ring, or knob, at either end, and a round foot. The longest portion of the stem is decorated with opaque-twist glass, in this case consisting of a few strands of glass twisted loosely down the length of the stem. A pattern of green and gilt leaves decorates the exterior of the glass at the bottom of the bowl and at the top of the foot. Narrow bands of gilding circle the glass at the rim, on both rings on the stem, and at the edge of the foot.
