Title Wine Glasses

Date 1790-1810

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Blown colorless non-lead glass

Description Pair of wine glasses made from blown colorless non-lead glass. Each wine glass has a plain rim, tapered sides and stem, and a round foot with a pontil mark on the bottom. Pontil mark: A rough place on a blown glass object where the solid metal rod, or pontil, is cracked off the object after final shaping and decoration. Pontil marks can be polished to achieve a smooth surface.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x diameter of each wine glass): 4 1/2 x 2 3/8in. (11.4 x 6cm)
