

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Child's Plate

Date 1880-1890

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Tinware

Description Pressed tin plate with a 3/4 inch wide rim and a shallow well. The rim is decorated with the raised capital letters of the alphabet; the 'A' and 'Z' are separated by a '&', or ampersand. The well has a raised image of an elephant standing on all four legs; below the elephant is the name "JUMBO". The outer edge of the rim is folded under slightly. At one time the plate was coated with silver or nickel; this has completely worn away. There are several small areas of rust on the top surface of the plate.
