women in bathing suits, sailing, playing, and swimming on the Long Island

shoreline. Other views include private residences along the shore, Hotel

Griswold, boat houses, sunbathers, the boardwalk on Hammonasset, the

Madison Beach Hotel and cottages, beach umbrellas, automobiles, boats, picnic

areas, ice-cream parlors, and Hillyer's Public Bath Houses.
