Title Map of the Land adjoining the Parsonage House belonging to the Second Ecclesiastical Society

Description Plat of land on Main Street in Hartford, Connecticut, that belonged to the Second Ecclesiastical Society. At the bottom left corner of the land is John Williams' house, which encroaches on the Society's land by one and a half feet, as noted in an inscription. In the bottom right corner is another building, which is not labeled. In each of the corners of the property and the "mutual gangway," there is a square with the inscription "Mur stone" next to it.
