Description Bird's-eye view of part of Hartford, Connecticut commemorating the 225th anniversary of the Hartford Courant. Asylum Hill is to the north, Founders Bridge to the east, Colt Park to the south, and Frog Hollow to the west. The image shows the city streets, buildings (businesses, residences and public buildings), traffic in the city and on the freeways, and boats in the river. Some of the notable buildings are labeled (the Civic Center, the Old State House, City Hall, Wadsworth Atheneum, etc.), as are the neighborhoods. The poster was produced by the Hartford Courant, and a short paragraph at the bottom of the sheet describes the city's and the newspaper's growth.
