Description Map of Long Island, most of Connecticut minus the northwest corner, and the eastern part of Massachusetts, depicting the railroad route between New York City and Boston. The railroads are not labeled, but show the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad and the Air Line. Other railroads include the Western Railroad; the New Haven-Springfield Line of the Hartford and New Haven Railroad; the Stonington Railroad; the Providence Railroad; and the Boston and Worcester Railroad.
