Description Map of a large portion of Hartford County, including Hartford, East Hartford, Manchester, South Windsor, Glastonbury, Rocky Hill, Wethersfield, New Britain, Berlin, West Hartford, Bloomfield, Windsor, and parts of Farmington, Avon, Simsbury, Granby, East Granby, Windsor Locks, and East Windsor. Rivers and ponds are colored blue. All state highways, local roads, and streets are identified by name or number. A "proposed expressway" is shown crossing the Connecticut River at Windsor Locks. A key to the streets extends across the lower portion of the map and continues at upper right..
