## **Title Tobacco plantation in the Connecticut Valley**

Date about 1945

Medium Photomechanical reproduction; printer's ink on postcard

Description Three men, one wearing a beaked cap, stand in a dirt lane between two tobacco fields. The field on the right is entirely enclosed by tobacco netting.

The netting on the left has been rolled up, revealing rows of tobacco plants.
