Description Canoes are on the sandy shore and in the water in the foreground.

They are decorated with designs that are supposed to be Native American. The

men in the canoes are dressed in costumes, including feathers, tights and

jerseys that are supposed to be Native American. Pleasure boats, including

sailboats and launches, some dressed with signal flags, are near the East

Hartford shore. A crowd of spectators is in the right background. Policemen on

horseback and a hound dog are nearby. Bunting decorates a building in the

background.
