**Title** Averill building after a fire, 420-424 Main Street, Hartford,

**January 1887**

Description Two brick commercial building damaged by fire. The roofs are gone, most windows are missing or broken and most shutters are missing or damaged. The first-floor storefronts appear to be burned-out. Ice and icicles hang from the ruins and from surrounding buildings. Spectators stand on the sidewalk. Rubble and debris are in the street. A horse appears to be hitched to a wagon.
