Description Black and white photograph by Thomas F. Oakes, above-ground view of the rear entrance to the Führerbunker complex, Hitler's final headquarters and site of his suicide. The photograph features a view of the emergency exit in the left background; the cone-shaped structure on the right served as a bomb shelter for the guards and as a ventilation shaft.
