Beattie Granite Works with the schooner, TOM BEATTIE, building a jetty at

Saybrook on the Connecticut River, 17 April 1914. Two men, John Walker [left]

and Fred Chapman [right], stand on a stone jetty as a block of stone is lowered

from the Tom Beattie. Three men stand on the schooner, two of the men, John

Corbett [left] and Joe Josephson [right] stand near the hoist, and John Larkin

stands towards the stern facing the men on the jetty. The men' s names and the

date, April 17, 1914, are written on the lower portion of the original image.

Saybrook Breakwater Lighthouse is visible in the far background.
