

# Basic Detail Report

**Title** Thomas K. Brace

Date about 1855

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Daguerreotype; oval shaped silver-plated copper plate in brass mat package in half of a velvet-covered case

Description Oval shaped ninth plate daguerreotype of Thomas K. Brace, taken around 1850. Brace is probably in his 30s. He is wearing a dark jacket with some sheen to it, a dotted vest, and striped trousers. His shirt is white, as is his upturned collar. He is wearing a large bowtie, a handkerchief or pocket square in his breast pocket, a ring on his right pinky, and a watch chain on his vest.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $2\frac{3}{4} \times 2\frac{1}{4}$ in. ( $7 \times 5.7$ cm) Other (height x width x depth):  $3\frac{1}{8} \times 2\frac{5}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ( $7.9 \times 6.7 \times 1.3$ cm)
