Medium Tintype; collodion on iron in brass window mat in tooled leather-covered case; red velvet pad in left side of open case

Description Sixth plate tintype of Moses Butler Bull by an unknown photographer. He is wearing a dark vest with a shawl collar, a white shirt, dark bowtie, and a dark jacket. He is holding what appears to be a cane in his right hand. His hair is white and worn long at the front and standing up. He has thick, white sideburns and a beard worn in a chin curtain style. There is the faint outline of an oval around the subject, which indicates that there was once (originally?) a window mat of a different shape covering the plate.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (7.6 $\times$ 7cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. (9.5 $\times$ 8.3 $\times$ 1.3cm)
