Medium Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate in brass window mat package (brass mat preserver is missing) in tooled leather-covered wooden case. Wine-colored silk pad in left side of open case

Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype of James M. Bunce. Bunce is wearing a dark jacket with wide lapels, a light-colored vest, a white shirt with a wingtip collar, and a dark tie. His curly hair is worn slightly long.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in. ($9.2 \times 7.9 \times 1.3$ cm)
