Primary Maker Abigail Hurlbut Case

Medium Daguerreotype; silver-coated copper plate in brass window mat package (missing the brass mat preserver) in a tooled leather-covered wooden case. Red silk pad in other half of case

Description Sixth-plate daguerreotype of Abigail Hurlburt Case by an unknown photographer. She is wearing a dark dress with vertical pleats on the bodice, a white lace collar, and small lace cuffs at the sleeves. She is holding in her hand a daguerreotype case.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3 × 7cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. (8.9 × 7.9 × 1.3cm)
