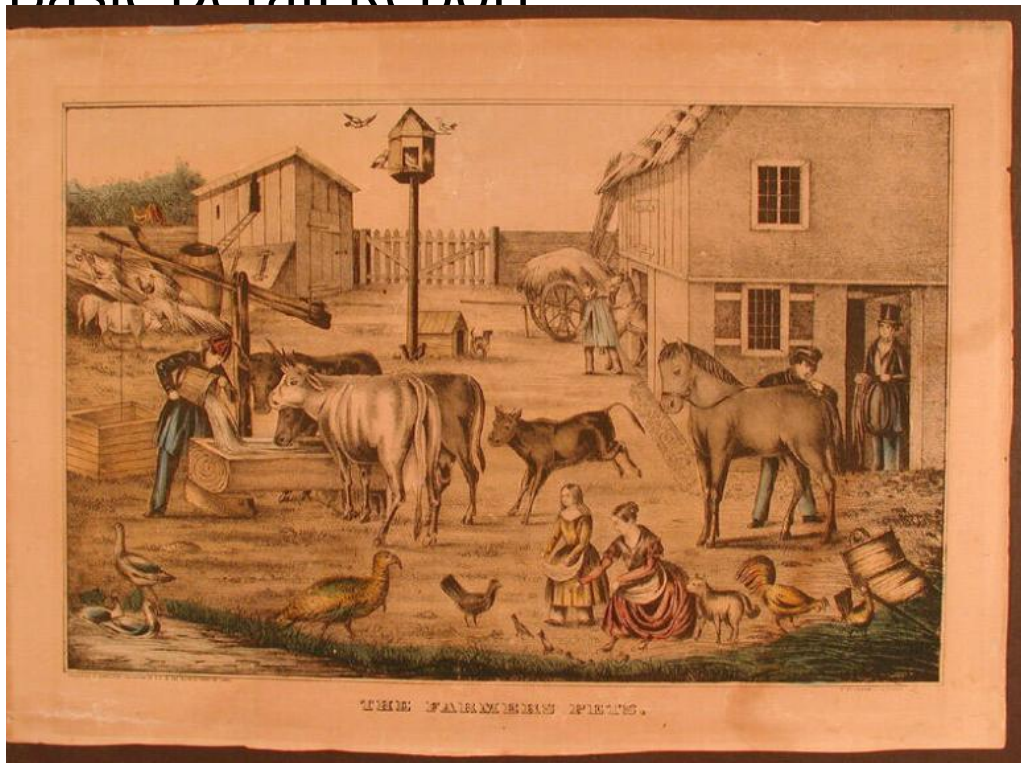

barrel, a pile of hay, more chickens, and pigs are in the left background.
