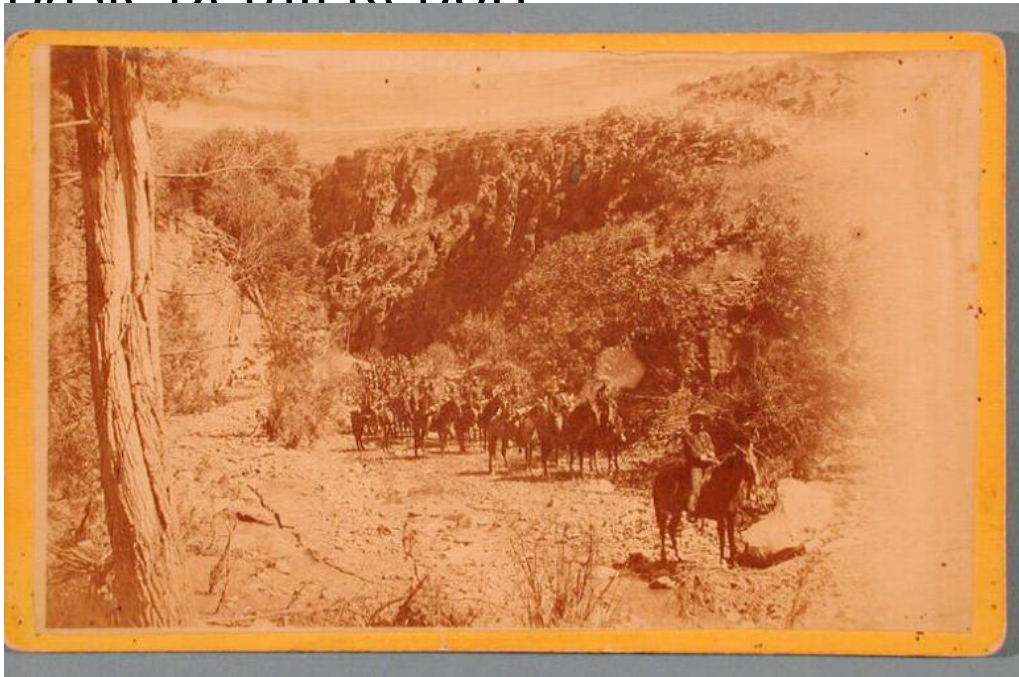


Basic Detail Report

Description Men in uniform, most of them on horseback, ride through canyons and desert in the American Southwest. One photograph shows an army camp with tents pitched in rows and horses picketed at the right. Covered wagons, presumably supply wagons, are in the foreground. Mules drawing a covered wagon stand in front of a rocky cliff. A cross, presumably a red cross, is on the side of the wagon. Men on horseback cross a bridge across a rushing stream. Men in uniform march in files along a dirt road.
