## Title Doorknob

Date 1852 to about 1900

Primary Maker The Russell and Erwin Manufacturing Company

Medium Mold-formed marbelized stoneware with a lead glaze; iron

Description Round doorknob made of stoneware with a marbelized appearance, created by mixing at least two different colors of clay. The ceramic was coated with a clear lead glaze, then mounted on a cylindrical iron support with a square opening in the center. The iron part of the doorknob is rusty. There are light scratches in the glaze on the ceramic portions of the doorknob.
