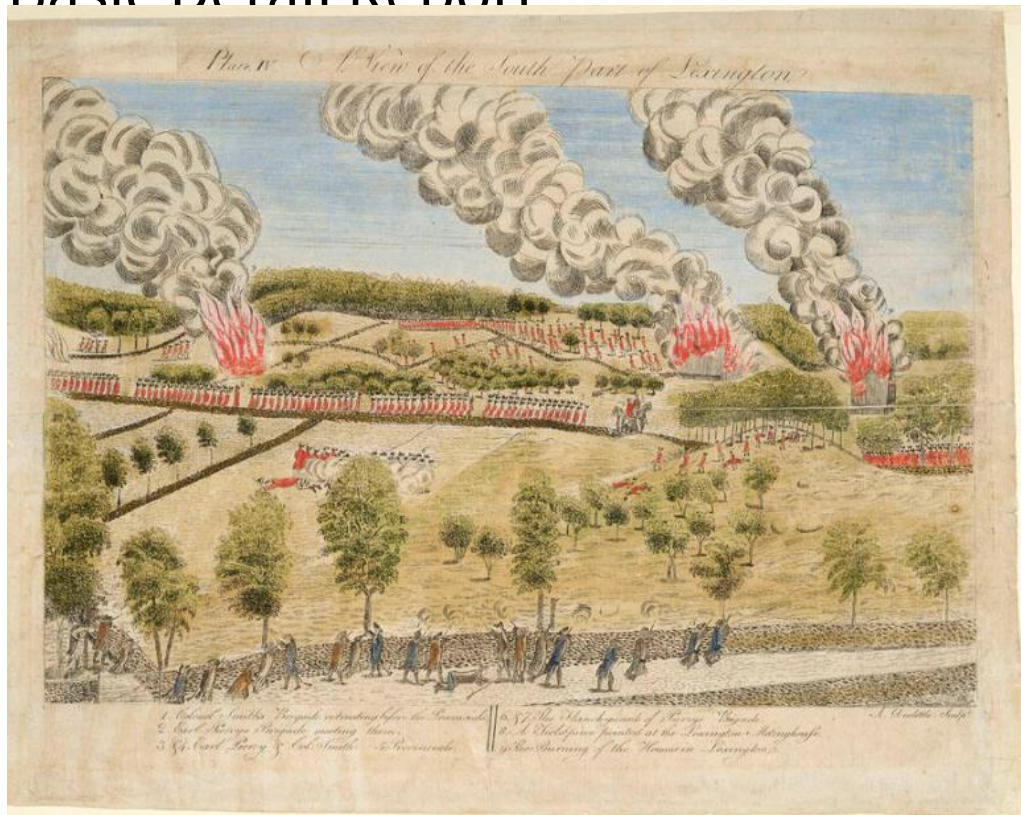

Description Colonial militia fire from behind a high stone wall at British troops marching along a road bordered by stone walls in the background. Some soldiers have fallen and others flee across a field between small trees. Other soldiers set fire to frame buildings in the background. Smoke billows into the sky.
