Title Connecticut State Armory under construction, Hartford

Description The central part of the facade of the Connecticut State Armory is enclosed in scaffolding. The peak of the gable roof appears to be incomplete.

The building is constructed of rough granite masonry with a projecting central block connected to end pavilions by recessed wings. Construction equipment and materials, including cranes, lumber, and barrels, surrounds the building.

The Park River is in the immediate foreground in front of a high stone retaining wall.
