# Basic Detail Report

Description Ninth plate ambrotype portrait of Ellen Cornelia Pomeroy before she married Thomas Mills Day by an unknown photographer. The plate is dark so it is difficult to make out her clothing. Notably, she is wearing a veiled bonnet with a frilled or lacy edge that frames her face and flowers at the top. It is tied under her chin with wide ribbons.

Dimensions Plate (image plate height x width):  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2$ in. ( $6.4 \times 5.1$ cm) Other (case height x width x depth):  $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ( $7.3 \times 6.4 \times 1.3$ cm)
